Courses will be cancelled if there are insufficient numbers from a week before the course start date.

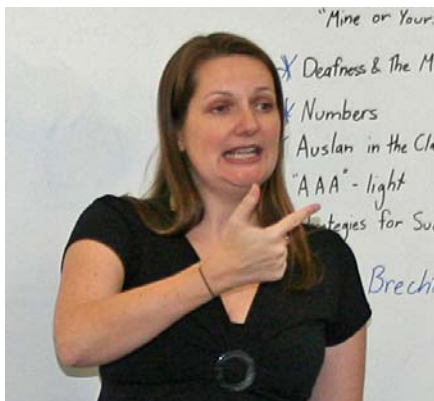

These courses are for people who:

- Want to be introduced to Auslan (Australian Sign Language) and Deaf culture
- Want a short course at a relaxed pace
- Want to attend classes within their local area
- Are managers, employers, teachers, health professionals, friends and colleagues of Deaf people
- Are interested in working with Deaf people

You will:

- Develop an appreciation for Auslan
- Access genuine Auslan with Deaf teachers
- Develop practical Auslan skills
- Learn through fun and informal classes
- Receive a good introduction before committing to accredited courses

### **Sign Language 1 (Auslan)**

*Sign Language 1* offers you the unique and fun experience of communicating visually using Auslan, the natural language of the Australian Deaf Community.

Taught by both Deaf and hearing teachers.

You will:

- Use basic communication skills in Auslan
- Use visual-gestural communication strategies
- Identify the Deaf Community
- Explain effective ways of communicating with Deaf people
- Be introduced to fingerspelling patterns

No pre-requisite.

### **Sign Language 2 (Auslan)**

*Sign Language 2* continues the unique and fun experience of communicating visually using Australian Sign Language (Auslan), the natural visual-gestural language used by the Australian Deaf Community.

Taught by Deaf teachers only.

You will:

- Improve communication skills in Auslan
- Further develop visual-gestural communication strategies.
- Extend your ability to adapt signs for use in different contexts
- Cover topics including occupations, suburbs, directions, families, time, appointments, countries and many more.

Pre-requisite: *Sign Language 1*

## Auslan Only Weekend (AOW)

A no-voice, fully catered residential weekend. Available at 2 levels, this award-winning program will amaze, challenge and delight all participants who will:

- Experience living with native signers in an Auslan only environment.
- Be challenged by group and individual tasks to achieve goals, using sign knowledge and visual expression.
- Experience formal and informal settings in Auslan.
- Maximise their learning experience through total immersion in the language and the culture.



### AOW 1

Participants will:

- Extend their vocabulary and ability to communicate visually
- Focus on the importance of classifiers and how to use them
- Learn through teamwork

Prerequisite: completion of *AOBBQ*.

### AOW 2

Participants will:

- Focus on the skills needed to negotiate and explain
- Work in groups to achieve individual goals
- Be challenged to think about the Deaf Community and Culture from many different perspectives

Prerequisite: Completion of *Certificate II in Auslan* or equivalent.

### AOW 3

Participants will:

- Use a range of signing methods, including hand-over-hand and fingerspelling, to communicate.
- Focus on the language components utilised in storytelling, including the use of space, non-manual features and Productive Signs.
- Be exposed to a diversity of signing styles in a supportive voice-off environment.

Prerequisite: Currently undertaking study of *Certificate II in Auslan* or higher.

## Auslan Only BBQ (AOBBQ)



A four hour, structured language workshop conducted entirely in Auslan. Participants are supported and encouraged throughout the day by members of the Deaf community.

Participants will:

- Meet and learn from members of the Deaf Community
- Experience activities and a BBQ within a Deaf cultural environment
- Use Auslan in a safe environment
- Make new friends and have fun
- Learn new Auslan vocabulary
- Experience total immersion in a Deaf social environment
- Increase your confidence in using Auslan

Prerequisite: You need to have completed *Sign Language 2 Community Auslan* course or equivalent before enrolling in *AOBBQ*.
